

144-hour Visa free Transit CHINA: Shanghai & Jiangsu & Zhejiang Information

SUMMARY

Since January 30th, 2016, the 144-hour visa-free policy has been carried out in Shanghai, Jiangsu & Zhejiang, which allows passengers from 51 countries or regions to transit in Shanghai, Jiangsu & Zhejiang for no more than 144 hours (six days) without holding a visa. 144 hours count from the second day of enter the country.

51 Countries & regions including:

Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherland, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Russia, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Romania, Ukraine, Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Montenegro, Macedonia (FYROM), Albania, the United States, Canada, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Australia, New Zealand, Korea, Japan, Singapore, Brunei, United Arab Emirates, Qatar.

FAQ

- What documents needed for allocations?

1. Valid Passport
2. Confirmed onward ticket to a third Country or region
3. Visa for a third country/region (if needed)
4. A fully completed Arrival/Departure Card

- Which transit ports are eligible?

Eligible Transit Ports:

Jiangsu: Nanjing Lukou Airport

Zhejiang: Hangzhou Xiaoshan Airport

Shanghai: All air, Sea, and railway ports of Shanghai

- What is the range of the eligible activity area?

The eligible administrative region include Shanghai City, Jiangsu Province & Zhejiang Province. During the layover period, you can travel within the administrative regions of Shanghai, Jiangsu and Zhejiang, but can't leave for other cities or province.

- Can I arrive at one eligible transit port and leave from another eligible transit port?

Yes. For example, you can arrive from Shanghai international airport transit port and leave from Nanjing Lukou Airport transit port.

- How to count the 144 hours?

144 hours is counted from the second day of enter the country. So means if you arrives at 14:30 10th Sep; means the 144 hours counted from 00:00 11st Sep, until 1 6th Sep 23:59 depart flight will be fine.

(Warm Reminder: please do not make a tight schedule, in case over the 144 hours limitation and causing some inconveniences for your trip)

- Others

- For immigration purpose, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan can deemed to be the third country (region)
- Going back to the same country is not apply to this policy.
- A double or multiple transit in China is not allowed
