- **Short description:** There's an abundance of MIGs, helicopters, army trucks, radar, artillery pieces, tanks, etc. Much of the equipment was given to the Vietnamese by the USSR and one piece even came to them from the Germans by way of the Soviets. One of the pieces is a huge helicopter in back. There's also the wreckage of an American jet aircraft from a carrier.

- **Short description:** Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum is the historic place where ‘Uncle Ho’ read the Vietnam Manifesto on September 2nd, 1945. There are always two guard men dressed in white uniforms standing at the main entrance every day.

- **Short description:** This thought-provoking site is all that remains of the former Hoa Lo Prison, ironically nicknamed the ‘Hanoi Hilton’ by US POWs during the American War. Most exhibits relate to the prison’s use up to the mid-1950s, focusing on the Vietnamese struggle for independence from France. A gruesome relic is the ominous French guillotine, used to behead Vietnamese revolutionaries. There are also displays focusing on the American pilots who were incarcerated at Hoa Lo during the American War.

In 1958, the Vietnam Government officially took over this cultural building and started to research, collect and supplement materials and objects, converting the contents from eastern arts into national history. On 3 September 1958, the National Museum of Vietnam History was officially opened for visitors..
