

VIETNAM TIPPING POLICY

Tip when you are pleased with the service received, and do not tip if you don't feel you have been given good service. Never feel obliged to tip – it is always discretionary and although often never expected in Asia, tipping is most welcome by people in the service industries. The following is just a guide to gauge an appropriate amount to tip and not all inclusive:

FIT < 6 pax	US\$ 12-15 /grp/day (USD 14 for 2 pax)
Group 7-15 pax	US\$ 15-20 /grp/day
Group 15 pax up	US\$ 20-30 /grp/day
MICE	US\$ 30-35/grp/day

FIT < 6 pax	US\$ 15-20 /grp/day
Group 7-15 pax	US\$ 20-25 /grp/day
Group 15 pax up	US\$ 25-30 /grp/day

City Transfers	US\$ 6-10 /day/booking (USD 8 for group of 2 pax)
Upcountry	
Incentive Groups	US\$ 10/day/group
Bus boy (helper)	US\$4/day
Cyclo, Tuk-Tuks	US\$ 1-\$2 /pax
Boat crew	
Short tour (1-2 hour)	US\$ 3-5/sampan, 5 per couple
Long tour (half day)	US\$ 6-8 / 8 per couple
Cruise with O/N	US\$ 10 /cabin/night
Hotels	
Porters	US\$ 1 /luggage
Restaurant (waiters)	
Pre-arranged meals	US\$ 1 /pax
Meal on client's own	5-10% on top of bill
